



Student Protection Policy: Law Enforcement and Immigration Officials

Coral Community Charter School (CCCS) shall protect the safety and welfare of all students and families on campus.

Outside law enforcement who are not specifically assigned to the school, shall request permission to access a school campus from the Executive Director prior to entering campus unless there is an emergency; they were called by a school employee; or they are entering the campus under a lawful court order.

Immigration officials shall not be permitted on the school campus at any time unless under a lawful court order. Agencies shall be escorted while on a school campus, including law enforcement and social services.

The Executive Director shall implement processes to protect all students and families while they are on campus.

CCCS does not collect nor provide information regarding immigration status of any student to law enforcement agencies, unless ordered to do so by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
